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Phoenix Metro Area Local 0093 Update concerning payroll glitch.

From Omar Gonzalez APWU Western Region Coordinator dated 10/18/18:

Alert: Pay Period 21 Payroll Issue

A Payroll programming issue primarily related to APWU employees has resulted in premium pay hours not being processed for Pay period 21 dated 10/19/18.

*Other attendance code hours that do not affect pay may have also been impacted.

*Employees should be encouraged to wait for accounting processed corrections whenever possible.

*Every effort is being made to address and rectify this issue as quickly as possible, thus:

*A majority of the hours adjustments will be processed shortly and any missing pay will be included in Your pay on November 2nd. Adjustments that do not impact your pay or do not significantly impact Your pay will be included in your pay on November 16th.

*Salary advances in accordance with Policy F-101 Section 23.3-Employee Emergency Salary Issuance will be offered to those who request one. All adjustments are to be processed through use of adjust pay.

*The portion of the policy that states that only salary will be advanced is waived. Premium pay will be advanced upon request for any employee impacted in pp-21 only.

*In addition, the portion of the policy that states that claims for less than a full day of pay will not be advanced is also waived. Salary advances for less than a full day of pay will be authorized for any employee impacted in pp-21 who requests a salary advance.

Adjust pay entries input by October 21st will be reflected on pp-22 check.

Nationwide impact of 90,000 APWU represented employees. Locally we have 900+ impacted.

Our Stewards have lists of employees impacted but need pay stubs and employee statements. Request a Steward, you worked and it's your money!
